Introduction:

Nanotechnology is a technology that allows the development of materials with improved or totally new properties. Changing the properties of materials without affecting their chemical composition can now be easily achieved utilizing nanotechnology. The building and construction industry is a major beneficiary of nanotechnology due to its significant impact on improving the physical and mechanical properties of the materials. Therefore, it is considered to be a base for future development. The application of nanotechnology can be of great help in innovative green and sustainable construction.

This series of conferences started in 2009. The conference gathered participants from different countries in the world and provided a platform for discussing and reporting research results. HBRC, ERU and ISTU agreed upon organizing the current conference to explore potentials and facilitate the cooperation in nanotechnology fields.

Objectives:

This conference aims at stimulating international collaborative research in nanotechnology, discussing the application of recent related research results in the field and providing an opportunity for scientists and practicing engineers from different countries and disciplines to exchange ideas and experience.

Guidelines for preparation of papers:

Summaries and full texts of papers should be submitted in electronic form prepared using MS word 2003/2016, according to the template available on website www.ntchbrc.com. Manuscripts must be a max. of 12 A4 pages. The font is to be Times New roman, font size 12, single line spacing, margins (Top, Bottom, right, left) 25 mm. The text should include the title, authors names, degree, position, institution, telephone number, email address, abstract (1 paragraph) and keywords (5-8). All figures and tables should be enumerated and entitled.

Conference Themes

Themes of the conference include but are not limited to:

1. Nanoparticles synthesis and applications.
2. Nanoscale materials characterization.
3. Nanostructured or nanoporous materials and nanocomposites
4. Nanomaterials for structural health monitoring and sensing.
5. Application of nanotechnology in paints, coatings, layers and membranes.
6. Nanomaterials in architecture for energy efficiency, indoor environmental quality and sustainability.
7. Nano-technology's effect of fire performance.
8. Others.

Conference Fees:
