


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FOREWORD TO THE SECOND EDITION

The publication of BUILDING BULLETIN No. 9 in March, 1953, aroused considerable interest, and it was felt that a second edition should be prepared which would take into account a number of changes. The most important is the production of the new Archrome 2 Range, to bring it into line with the new British Standard Colours for Building and Decorative Paints (B.S.I. No. 2660) issued in January, 1956.

In addition there are a number of changes in the text, particularly in Appendices 2 and 3. All substantial alterations in the text are marked with a side-line.



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
